

GARDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES
SPECIAL MEETING
September 27, 2021

The special meeting was called to order with the Pledge of Allegiance at 6:04 p.m. by Gary Sporer

PURPOSE: The purpose of this meeting was to finalize and approve payment of the new brush truck for the Fire Department.

BRUSH TRUCK: 1st Attack has finished up the brush truck. The final invoice was received in the amount of \$36,920.00 which should be paid by the Fire Department escrow account upon transfer to the checking account. Brenda made a motion, seconded by Sue, to approve payment to 1st Attack in the amount of \$36,920.00 for the final payment on the brush truck. Roll Call Vote: Sue – yes, Janet – yes, and Brenda – yes. Motion carried. The final payment to 1st Attack will be sent certified mail. Brenda made a motion, seconded by Janet, to have Pro Towing pick up and deliver the new brush truck from Waterloo, Indiana provided their fee is at or below \$1,200.00 with the approval the payment could be made to Pro Towing upon delivery. Roll Call Vote: Sue – yes, Janet – yes, and Brenda – yes. Motion carried.

OTHER BUSINESS: The Fire Department has the chance to get some free used fire equipment from Belfor Company who will be coming to Escanaba Township with three semi-trucks filled with equipment. Garden Township will have first chance to get a cascade system that is worth \$50,000. There will be other equipment as well. The only charge would be around \$200.00 to help cover lodging and meals for the Belfor drivers who will be bringing the equipment. This may be paid from Besse Funds that were previously received as a donation.
