Village of Garden Clean-up is scheduled for September 28<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 a.m. at the Village of Garden Pavilion. The purpose will be for members of the community to assist the Village in clearing out ditches to help alleviate flooding issues that arise every spring. Following clean-up will be a potluck. The Village of Garden will supply the meat. Please bring a dish to pass.

Heritage will move out of the Fire Station space as of September 30<sup>th</sup>. They have rented this space from the Township for the past 7-years. DTE Electric Company (DTE) is buying Heritage's Garden/Fairbanks Wind Farm Operations. DTE will purchase the existing Garden I Wind Farm - subject to receipt of government approvals - but Heritage will continue operations until January 1, 2021. Similarly, Heritage will control and finance construction of the Fairbanks Wind Park. After it becomes operational and if all conditions are met, DTE will then purchase the Fairbanks Wind Park. It is anticipated that this will occur in the fourth quarter of 2020.

The septic at the Garden Township Hall needs replacing. The cost will run approximately \$35,000.00 which includes surveys,
