So far we are thinking of pictures that reflect the logging, Ire Ore smelting, farming, Fayette State Park,

Taxes – Last day to pay taxes without penalty is February 14th. Our Treasurer can take taxes until February 29th, then you will have to send your payment to the Delta County Treasurer.

Board of Review dates at the Township Hall:

- The replacement of the septic at the Garden Township Hall is in process. The survey has been completed; the Health Department has given us the go-ahead. A-1 Septic was chosen to put in the septic. This will be done once the snow melts. We are also requesting bids for a fence to protect the drain field.
- Our speaker system was brought into Manistique Radio Center to get all the microphones working.
- Tri-Star EMS will continue to share the Fire Department's spaces. They will be responsible for 1/3 of the utility bills.
- The Delta County Board of Commissioners approved zoning for Storage units at Garden Corners.
- The Township found out that we have not been in compliance with the Department of Transportation Regulations regarding Commercial Driver's License (CDL) drivers. If an employee is hired based on their CDL, then a drug screening program/policy must be established and enforced. The Township is in the process of implementing this program and policy.
- We are experiencing vandalism at the Township Hall. After letting some residents use the hall to play basketball, we found damage to the ceiling tiles. Because of this, the Hall is no longer available for basketball until further notice. We are in the process of developing a policy for Township Hall use.
- The Delta County Township Association is working with all the County Township to put up 911 signs for our first responders. Our Township has provided updated grids (showing new homes & addresses) to CUPPAD. CUPPAD has finished updating the grids. These grids will be provided to the 911 sign company to put the 911 signs up in the spring. This will cost approximately \$23,000.
- 2020/2021 Budget meetings have been set for 6 pm on January 28^{th} , February 4^{th} , and February 25^{th} .
